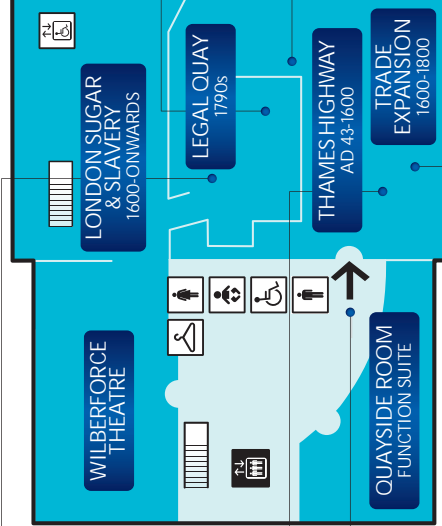

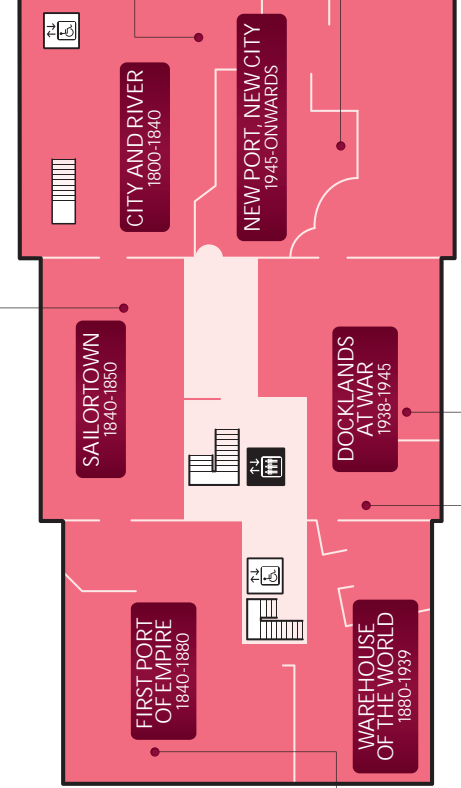

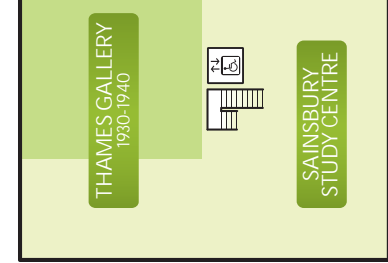

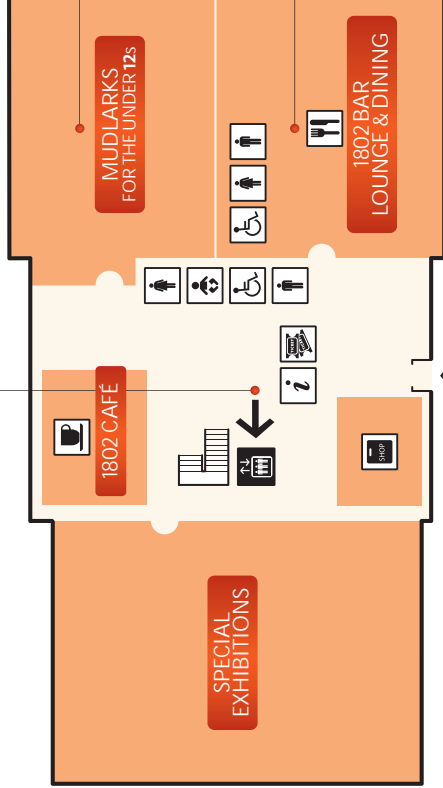
From Roman settlement to Docklands' regeneration, explore this 200 year old former warehouse and discover the history of London's river, port and people.

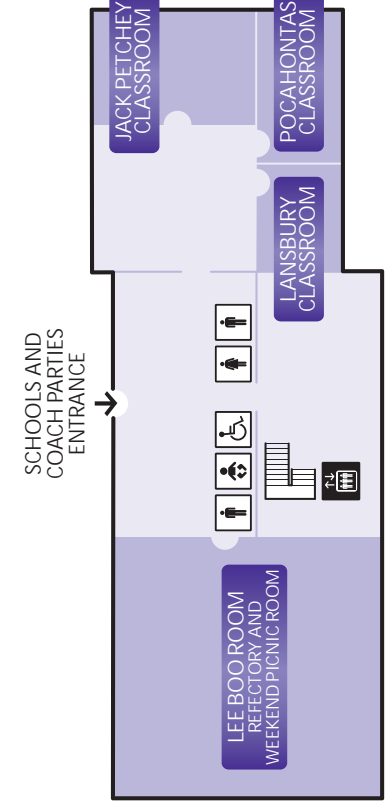
